

HOCKEY CAMP PARENT INFORMATION



Sign In/Out Procedure.

Camp hours 9:30am-12:30pm

On-ice time: 10am-12:00pm

- Please sign your child in each morning. Also, please verify the person picking up your child from camp is on their authorized pick up list (must be on authorization list in camper's packet) **Photo IDs will be checked when the child is signed out, even if the staff know you. The sign-out book will be at the front desk.** Campers are not allowed to leave the facility. There is one counselor for every 15 campers.

Late pick up/ early drop off will be charged accordingly (\$1 per minute)

Spending Money

If your child has spending money, it's recommended to place the money on your child's in house account or place the money in a secure container in your child's back pack or bag. Skatetown is not responsible for lost or stolen money amongst campers. It is highly suggested to pack your camper a snack and a water bottle to avoid children keeping track of money.

What to Bring

- Full hockey gear, skates and stick
- Campers should wear a base layer under their hockey gear including one pair of tall, thin socks.
- Be sure to label all of your belongings!
- Hockey jersey-bring a light and dark jersey.
- Snack and refillable water bottle (label the bottle with full name).

Skatetown Café

- The café will not be open until 3pm. Campers should bring refillable water bottles and snack.

Structured On-Ice Activities

We request that **all** campers participate in activities. Campers who do not wish to participate can sit on the bleachers and watch. We ask that you remind your camper that he/she needs to participate fully. Campers roaming around the rink unsupervised will be asked to call their parent(s) to be picked up.

Lockerrooms

Campers will dress in lockerrooms. Backpacks, snacks and other gear will be kept in the lockerrooms.

Redemption Games are not a camp cool activity. If your child would like to play these games they will need to do so before or after camp.

Camper Behavior

In order to provide a positive and safe experience for all campers, it is essential that all rules are understood and followed. **Please review the following camp rules with your child:**

- Campers are required to be polite and respectful to each other and to the facility. Campers who act inappropriately toward a person or who intentionally cause damage to the facility will not be allowed to continue attending camp. **No refunds will be issued to campers who miss any portion of camp due to their behavior.**
- Campers must be able to follow directions given by camp counselors or staff.
- Campers are NOT permitted to be in the front lobby area or in the Pro Shop unless accompanied by a parent.
- Campers are NOT permitted to exit the facility unless they are with a counselor.
