As you may already know, the ISI is a worldwide recreational ice skating program for ice skaters of all ages and abilities. It includes teaching and testing programs with award patches for 76 different levels of achievement in basic skills, freestyle, figures, couples, dance, pairs, hockey and speed skating. It also encourages fun and recreational competition, where everyone is rewarded for trying their best. If you are not already a member of ISI, it is easy to join at [www.SkateISI.org](http://www.SkateISI.org) or at our front desk. Membership is just \$15.00 and comes with many benefits.

Skatetown's annual "Be A Star" Competition is an exciting and fun experience – perfect for the first-time competitor to show off their skills while performing to their favorite song, or just competing individual maneuvers. **It is recommended that you hire a private coach to help with the events in which you may want to compete.** There will be a \$\$ charge for the coaches' work which may include choreography, music editing, event supervision, etc. However, some events will not require any private instruction; Check with your class instructor for more information about those events. The competition is designed so that all skaters come away from the experience feeling good about what they have accomplished. Competitors compete against skaters their own age and ability. **"Events are offered to all ages - Tots through Adults"**

**Every competitor will receive a medal for their efforts!**

Any music is acceptable and must be turned in on a cd. This program will contain required maneuvers learned in class. It is recommended that each skater take at least a 15 minute lesson once a week to prepare for the competition, if performing a routine.

In fairness to all our competitors, all instructors with students competing in this competition must do their part in judging an appropriate number of events.

### ENTRY and TEST DEADLINE

**Entries must be postmarked or faxed by Friday, January 31, 2020.** All competitors must be current members of the ISI with their tests registered in the national office by this date. Incomplete entries will not be accepted. Late entries, if accepted, will be charged double. All checks should be made out to SKATETOWN and include driver's license number, expiration date and date of birth. Sorry, no refunds for cancellations. **There will be a \$10 fee for making any changes to your original entry form once it has been submitted.**

### RINK SIZE

Competition ice surface is 200'x 85' with rounded corners.

### GENERAL RULES

This competition is open to all skaters who are current individual members of ISI and all ages Tots-Delta. Skaters must enter the highest test passed and registered with ISI. Skaters may enter more than one event in their level. This competition will be conducted in accordance with the guidelines contained in the most recent edition of the ISI Handbook, including all 2018 Rule Revisions. **We will be using the new 2018 Rules for this year's competition event.**

### MUSIC AND REGISTRATION

CDs (standard format only – no CDRW) will be accepted. Skater's name and category must be labeled on the CD with only one track and one piece of music per CD. Be sure to bring an extra copy in case there is a problem. Music must be turned in at the registration table one hour before warm up time. Please pick up your music when event is finished.

### JUDGING

In consideration of our goal to hold a fairly judged competition, we are requesting that every coach who is in attendance also participates as a judge. All coaches must also be current ISI Professional members.

### AWARDS

Awards will be presented by the photographer upon the posting of each completed event. Awards will be given to first through 5<sup>th</sup> place. Trophies will be presented to the top 5 teams. Each ice arena's competitors will earn points for their team. At the end of events, team points will be tallied and the award ceremony will close the Competition.

### VERIFICATION

Coaches must sign the entry form and verify that the information is accurate and complete. Information will be submitted for verification by ISI office. Inaccurate and/or incomplete forms will be returned and may miss entry deadline date.

### ACCOUNTING REVIEW

Only ISI Professional Members can make accounting review requests to the Competition Director. All judges scores are considered final. A review is simply a verification of these scores. There is a \$50.00 fee for all reviews. If an error is found, the fee will be refunded.

### SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

A schedule of events and judges sign up sheet will be posted approximately 7-10 days before competition date.

All routines shall start from a stationary position. The timing of a routine begins at any action

### **TINY TOT EVENT**

Open to skaters 6 years and under who have not passed Pre-Alpha tests. Skaters need a one minute program containing: March while moving, snowplow stop, beginning stroke, teapot, two foot jump in place, Three forward swizzles and backward wiggle. Tot skaters are not permitted nor required to perform an additional move from a higher test level. Tiny Tot skaters are permitted to have their instructor on the ice with them.

### **TECHNICAL EVENTS**

- Pre-Alpha through Delta skaters must include one and only one additional maneuver from Freestyle 1.
- In Beta, the foot must be lifted off the ice for the back crossovers, cutbacks do not meet the test standards.
- In Gamma, three strokes must precede the mohawk combination, for the total of seven steps.
- In Delta, the edges must be done consecutive outside-outside and inside-inside. The lunge must be done in a straight line and completed with a one-foot glide.
- For the safety of all skaters, backwards arabesques are not permitted during warm-up.

The Illusion is an uncaptured move and may be performed at the Freestyle 1 or higher.

### **STROKING EVENT**

Open to all Alpha, Beta, Gamma and Delta skaters. Skaters compete as a group and skate two laps around the ice in each direction. Judges look for cleanliness of edges, free leg extension, flexible skating knee, flow, posture, rhythm, and proper push technique. Crossovers are optional but **NOT** judged..

### **ENSEMBLE**

Similar to a Production team but an Ensemble team consists of 3-7 skaters. There are no test requirements and skating moves of any level may be performed though there is no technical score. Skaters are judged on entertainment value, performance and originality. Costume and Prop specifications are the same as Spotlight category. Program length is 3 minutes.

### **OPEN FREESTYLE**

All Freestyle skaters now have even more options to participate in ISI competition events. Skaters who have passed any level of traditional Freestyle 1-10 tests can also participate in the Open Freestyle events. **There are no required maneuvers for the Open Freestyle events and any spin can be performed at any level;** but all skaters and coaches should carefully check the jump limitations for the Bronze, Silver & Gold levels. The program should be well-balanced including jumps, spins, connecting moves, gliding maneuvers, etc. Skaters in FS1-3 can participate in the Bronze event and do maneuvers from FS3 and below; skaters in FS4-5 can be in the Silver event and do maneuvers from FS5 and below; skaters in FS6-7 can be in the Gold event and do maneuvers from FS7 and below; Open Gold Short FS6-7 maneuverers from F/S 7 and below, skaters in FS8-10 can be in the Platinum event and do any skating maneuvers. Open Platinum Short F/S 8-10 any maneuvers. **New Open Platinum Plus** F/S 8-10 any maneuvers

Judging criteria is: Correctness of jumps, Correctness of spins, Correctness of Turns/Edges, Variety of Moves, Music Interpretation, Choreography & Pattern, Posture, Presentation, Duration and General Overall.

Judging Criteria for Open Freestyle Short Program: (same as the long program) Correctness of Jumps, Correctness of Spins, Correctness of Turns & Edges, Choreography & Pattern, Variety of Moves, Music Interpretation, Posture, Presentation, Duration, General Overall

## **ARTISTIC**

Artistic skating is open to all Freestyle 1 level skaters and above.

FS 1-3 / Bronze FS 4 & below 1:30

FS 4-5 / Silver FS 6 & below 1:30

FS 6-7 / Gold FS **Any maneuvers** 2:00

FS 8-10 / Platinum Any maneuvers 2:00

There are no required elements and there is no grade for technical merit. Emphasis is on creative and innovative design of the skating program. Props are not permitted in this event. See the 2018 ISI Handbook.

**The Illusion is an uncaptured move and may be performed at the Freestyle 1 level or higher.**

## **SHOOT THE DUCK**

This is a timed event with skaters grouped by approximate age and test level. Timing begins when skater's hips are below knee level. Skaters may come up on two feet. A 20-second penalty will be given for a fall. Skaters are permitted to hold the free foot while performing the Shoot the Duck.

## **SPOTLIGHT PROGRAM DURATION AND PROP SPECIFICATIONS**

Timing for all spotlight routines begins when action starts, not to exceed 15 seconds after the music begins.

FS 1-3 / Bronze FS 4 & below 1:30

FS 4-5 / Silver FS 6 & below 1:30

FS 6-7 / Gold **Any maneuvers** 2:00

FS 8-10 / Platinum Any maneuvers 2:00

See the 2016 ISI Handbook for maneuver limitations. The penalty grade of 2.0 will be given to the skater under the costume and prop scene for exceeding the prop specifications. This penalty will be given for:

- Altering the ice with substances such as shaving cream, whipped cream etc.
- Exceeding the 30 seconds allowed for set up.
- Exceeding the 30 seconds allowed for leaving the ice.

Skatetown is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged props.

## **SPOTLIGHT CHARACTER**

Individual skaters portray a famous, easily identifiable character through the use of music, costume, props (optional) and the skater's actions. Opportunity exists here for the skater to be creative and original in an exciting performance.

## **SPOTLIGHT DRAMATIC**

A theatrical skating performance by individual skaters that evokes an emotional response from the judges and the audience. The skater's interpretation should create a mood that is enhanced by the style, creativity, costuming, and props (optional). The overall impression at the conclusion of the performance should be that it was a dramatic performance, not lighthearted as in the light entertainment category.

## **SPOTLIGHT LIGHT ENTERTAINMENT**

To entertain in a refreshing lighthearted, vaudevillian type fashion using music, costumes, props (optional), comedy, dance and skating moves.

## **FAMILY SPOTLIGHT**

Two or more family members only, of any age and skating level. Program length is 1 ½ minutes, and the routines may be fun, entertaining, emotional, or portrayals of characters using costumes and/or props. Use team/group entry.

## **SPOTLIGHT COUPLES**

Two skaters together perform a routine that is entertaining, emotional or a portrayal of characters using costumes and props (optional).

Platinum FS 8-10 / Platinum Any maneuvers 2:00

If skaters of different levels wish to compete together, they must compete and be prepared to follow the rules of the higher category.

## **FOOTWORK**

Skaters perform footwork sequences of their own design to music. The program should contain a variety of turns and sequences and it is suggested that there be a change of tempo to emphasize the skater's controlled edges and turns in addition to the speed and quickness of the routine. The one-minute program may contain ½ rotation jumps, and spins less than three revolutions. ½ loop stop. A ¼ loop landing on both feet (toe picks) has been allowed in Footwork events. However, due to confusion as to what this maneuver is and how to perform it, we have renamed this maneuver ½ loop Stop (uncaptured move). This event is open to skaters in Freestyle 1 and above.

The Illusion is now an uncaptured move and may be performed at any level in Footwork events.

Skaters must now enter Footwork events at their highest level test passed and registered in either ISI Dance or ISI Freestyle test.

## **RHYTHMIC SKATING**

Open to skaters in Freestyle 1-10 levels only. The skater chooses only one rhythmic prop per routine (ball, hoop, or ribbon) and must maintain control of the prop at all times throughout the program. No additional props are permitted.

FS 6-7 / Gold Any maneuvers 2:00

FS 8-10 / Platinum Any maneuvers 2:00

Judging Criteria is Music and choreography, Pattern, duration, use of prop and judges appeal.

## **SOLO COMPUSORIES**

The following three moves can be performed in any order, in a "mini-program" but with no music. Other jumps, spins or uncaptured moves are not allowed. Simple connecting moves are acceptable but not scored. Judging stops after one minute. **Note:** There is no penalty for the quality of swizzles, wiggles, strokes or crossovers performed in the Tot-Beta levels. Only the quality of the maneuvers is judged.

Skaters who have only passed an ISI Open Freestyle test must compete in Solo Compulsory event levels as follows: Bronze – Freestyle 3; Silver – Freestyle 5; Gold – Freestyle 7; Platinum – The skater can choose any Freestyle 8-10 level for their Solo Compulsory level. The opposite jump in Freestyle 7, 9, and 10 and the opposite spin in Freestyle 9 must be performed in both directions. (also applies to Team Compulsory Event)

### **HOCKEY SKATING EVENT**

Skaters will race one or two at a time skating one forward lap around the rink carrying the puck on the stick. After completing the forward lap, the skater will drop the puck, keep the stick and skate another lap around the rink backwards. The skater with the best time wins.

### **PUCK HANDLING & SHOOTING EVENT**

The skater will carry the puck on a prescribed course, skating around pylons, and will skate towards the net and take a shot. The skater with the fastest time wins. Timing begins when the skater touches the puck.

#### **PENALTIES**

1 SECOND ADDED FOR TOUCHING A PYLON

1 SECOND ADDED FOR FAILING TO SKATE AROUND A PYLON. (If a skater loses control, they can regain control and go back to the point where they lost control and continue)

In consideration of being allowed on Roseville Sportworld, Inc. (RSI or Skatetown) premises (including the parking lot), to attend, participate in, spectate, or volunteer in Skatetown on-ice or off-ice activities, and/or to use Skatetown equipment and facilities, I, the undersigned, (Participant) and/or my parent(s)/guardian(s) agree:

1. **Waiver and Release of Liability.**
  - a. Participant and/or Participant's parent(s)/guardian(s) forever release and discharge Skatetown and all of its shareholders, directors, officers, employees, agents, instructors, coaches, volunteers, and affiliated entities/companies (“Releasees”) from any and all liability for and forever waive all claims/causes of action for personal injury, disability, property loss/damage or death arising out of, relating to, or caused by activities at Skatetown and/or Releasees’ negligence. This waiver and release applies to all activities at Skatetown including, but not limited to, ice skating, ice skating lessons, speed skating, ice go-kart riding, ice tricycle riding, Zamboni riding, ice hockey, broom ball, off-ice activities, including use of party rooms, restaurant and other facilities, activities incidental to those activities, and rental and use of equipment used for on-ice or off-ice activities (“Activities”), whether as an active participant, attendee, spectator, or volunteer.
  - b. Participant and/or Participant’s parent(s)/guardian(s) intend this waiver and release to be a complete release of Releasees from any and all claims/causes of action for negligence, failure to perform maintenance, to inspect, to supervise or to control the premises, existence of and/or the failure to warn of dangerous conditions existing on the premises, and negligent supervision, training or instruction of employees, volunteers, coaches or any other agent of RSI and any and all rights to recover for personal injuries, disability, property loss/damage or death arising out of, relating to, or caused by activities at Skatetown and/or Releasees’ negligence.

3. **Agreement to Indemnify.** Participant and/or Participant's parent(s)/guardian(s) agree to indemnify and hold harmless Releasees from all liability, claims, demands, causes of action, charges, expenses, costs and attorney fees arising out of or related to Activities at Skatetown whether caused by any act or omission of Participant, Releasees or otherwise. Participant and/or participant's Parent(s)/guardian(s) also agree to pay Skatetown for any and all damage to its property, facilities and equipment caused by them.
4. **Consent and Agreement.** Participant and/or participant's Parent(s)/guardian(s) acknowledge they have read the above, have not relied upon any representations of RSI or Releasees, and are fully aware of the potential dangers of Activities on Skatetown premises. Minor participant’s parent(s)/guardian(s) agree they have assessed their minor’s age, experience and capabilities, understand the nature of the activity(ies) in which their minor will participate, and consent to such participation under this Agreement.
