Learn to Skate Classes



Class Fees 4-week intro - \$80 8-week beginner - \$145 13-week all levels - \$235

Tot Programs (Ages 4½-6)

- •Tot A For skaters who have never been on ice skates before or for those who have no formal lessons. Children should wear gloves and warm clothing. Please wear figure skates unless you can skate unassisted in hockey skates. Helmets are recommended. Loaner helmets are available at no cost
- •Tot B For skaters who have passed Tot A or have comparable skating skills
- ·Tot C For skaters who have passed Tot B

Youth and Adult Programs

- •Pre-Alpha For skaters who have had no formal lessons but must be able to skate unassisted. Students will learn basic forward and backward skating, one-foot glides and snowplow stops. Please wear figure skates unless you can skate unassisted in hockey skates. Helmets are recommended.
- ·Alpha For students who have passed Pre-Alpha or have comparable skating skills
- Beta For skaters who have passed Alpha
- ·Gamma For skaters who have passed Beta
- ·Delta For skaters who have passed Gamma

Freestyle

There are ten freestyle levels in the Ice Skating Institute program with varying degrees of difficulty at each level. Various jumps, spins, footwork and artistic maneuvers are taught in these classes.

Theatre On Ice Program

For skaters who have badge-tested Freestyle 1 and higher. Theatre On Ice combines the grace of figure skating with the excitement of theatre and dance and is usually based on a story or theme, using costumes, props and technical skating to enhance the production performance. Skating Programs

Private Lessons

Private instruction is available from Skatetown's professional staff. Lesson length varies from 15 to 60 minutes and may be scheduled on public or freestyle sessions. You may contact an instructor directly or complete a Private Lesson Request Form (online or in person) and an instructor will be assigned to you. Admission and skate rental fees are not included in the coaches fees.

\$38-\$53 for 30-minutes - coaches fees vary Online registration for private lessons is recommended.

Power Skating

Focusing on skating skills, lateral movements and stamina, this program is for the skater that has the desire to learn and a willingness to work hard. Power is not offered year-round. For more information, visit our website.

Freestyle Sessions

These sessions are primarily for competitive skaters who want to practice their programs as well as jumps and spins. Most private lessons are taught on freestyles. If you are unsure if a freestyle session is for you, ask your instructor. Click on the 'Schedule' tab on our website to check Freestyle schedules.

\$8.25 - 30 minutes, \$16.50 - 60 minutes (price depends on length). Most sessions are 30 minutes.

Online registration for freestyles is recommended.
